Words to use this week

penny (1 cent) · nickel (5 cents) · dime (10 cents) · quarter (25 cents) · "worth" · "cents"

How to run this sheet (10 minutes)

1. Put REAL coins next to each picture - the pictures are drawings; real coins are the lesson.
2. Say each name together, then let your child trace the word and repeat the value.
3. The tricky one: the dime is the SMALLEST coin but worth more than the bigger penny and nickel.
Say it out loud together: "size does not tell you what money is worth."
4. Section B: four dimes are hiding in the row. Hunt them by SIZE first - the little silver ones.

Answers

Section B: the dimes are coins 1, 4, 7, and 10 (four dimes total).
